Parent Teacher Interviews



As you know, Parent Teacher Interviews will take place week beginning 5th February 2024 and Children will go home after lunch the week of these interviews. These interviews will be face to face meetings and you will receive your interview times on or before Monday 29th January 2024.

We will run special 1-2pm and 2-3pm Clubs Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday of the week of parent teacher interviews. Each 1-hour session will cost £2 per child. Parents can enrol their child(ren) for as many sessions as required but should note that if you enrol your child for both daily sessions this will incur a cost of £4 per day. If you wish to register your child to attend, please complete the booking on School Money. Places are limited and booking will be on a first come, first served basis.

Registration for this will open next week and a text will be sent out. Once all places have been allocated, it will not be possible to enrol in Club.

To facilitate a smooth transition please see below for the times to pick up your children. To ensure that the school office is not overwhelmed, please do not ask office staff to get your children from other classes as there is only a five-minute wait on our P5-7 children getting out. Nursery to P4 children may be picked up from their usual playground and P5-7 children will be dismissed from the school gates, as normal. Please note, that the playground gates will not open until all classes have left the front playground.
