<u>Half Term</u>

School will finish at 2pm for all pupils on **Tuesday 13th February**. School bus will be at this earlier time of 2pm and there will be no 2-3 Club on Tuesday but Breakfast Club will operate as normal.

School will be closed from Wednesday 14th February, which is also Ash Wednesday, Thursday 15th and Friday 16th February. School will re-open on Monday 19th February as normal.

Parent Teacher Interviews

In the case of an emergency, where you are unable to attend this meeting at short notice, please



ensure that you phone the office to let the class teacher know. Where possible, an attempt will be made to re-arrange you meeting. Parents who require an interpreter will be provided with a different appointment.

A club form has been running for the past week, to facilitate working parents. These clubs will run from 1-2pm and 2-3pm on **Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday** next week and the cost per 1-hr session is £2, so if you enrol your child for both daily sessions this will incur a cost of £4 per day. As previously stated, school will close early for all children to facilitate these meetings. To ensure that the school office is not overwhelmed, please do not ask office staff to get your children from other classes as there is only a five-minute wait on our P5-7 children getting out. Nursery to P4 children may be picked up from their usual playground and P5-7 children will be dismissed from the school gates, as normal. Please note, that the playground gates will not open until all classes have left the front playground.

The newly reconstituted PTFA would like to start their year by running a low-key fundraiser before half-term.


On **Tuesday 13th February**, they have asked that the children get into Valentine's with a theme of "Wear Red to Show Your Love" non-uniform day.
