#### Covid Update

Thank you for all your support over the past weeks. It is essential that we all do our bit to protect the bubbles within our school and ensure that the school community remains safe during these unprecedented times. I Cannot stress enough that without your support, our

Parents must take all precautions to protect everyone in our school so please do not, under any circumstances, send a child to school where they display symptoms – cough, temperature and loss of smell or taste. Children usually display mild symptoms but the risk to adults is much more severe.

\*Parents are urged to inform the school office if their child receives a **POSITIVE PCR**. **TEST**.

From 10<sup>th</sup> September, the Public Health Agency (PHA) will undertake contact tracing for a positive PCR test. A letter from the Chief Medical Officer explaining this is displayed on our website. Please note the PHA close contact guidance is displayed on our website also.

## School Bus

The bus operates on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday at 3pm and Wednesday at 2pm. Children in P2, P3 and P4 (for the month of September) wishing to travel on the bus will be supervised in school until 3pm.

We would encourage the children to wear a mask. Our Bus Escort will be wearing one and also ensuring that the children are socially distanced on the bus.

A note of the current route and stops is as follows:-

#### Bus stops:

Cliftonpark Avenue → Summer Street → Manor Street → Agnes Street → Shankill Road → Woodvale Road → Crumlin Road then onto part of Ballysillan Road and turning down onto the Oldpark Road

Please look at these and email into the school if you would use the bus if an additional stop was added. The cost of this bus is £1.05 per day, paid directly to the bus driver.
