Covid Update

This week has again been athe most difficult week of the pandemic since the pandemic began, that we have experienced, bar none! Despite us being proactive and booking additional sub teachers in advance, we were unable to maintain face to face teaching for all classes. The outlook is better but we are still in a very precarious position but will attempt to rotate remote learning, in the event of staff levels remaining acute. I would advise all parents to ensure that they have a Plan B in the event that their Child's class is put onto remote learning.

As we have been seeing an increased number of cases amongst our school population, we will continue to monitor the situation and liaise with the Education Authority and the Public Health Association. If there is a cluster of cases identified within a particular year group or class, you will receive a letter that will advise that your child should take a lateral flow COVID test (LFT) at home before coming back into school.

We all have a responsibility to keep everyone safe and avoid multiple classes being put onto remote learning for sustained periods. However, the only way we can do this is if:

- We have available staff
- Parents keep Children off who are displaying symptoms
- Children do not attend school if awaiting results of a test
- Parents report positive Lateral Flows & PCR results to the School Office

I would urge all parents who believe that their Child(ren) have symptoms, to keep them off and even if they return a negative lateral flow, book them a PCR if in any doubt.

Parents should not send children to school who are awaiting the results of a PCR.
