As you know from the previous bulletin, teaching and non-teaching unions have directed their members that a full day of industrial action will take place on **Thursday 18**th **January**. After consultation with staff, unions and guidance provided by the Education Authority, I can confirm that school will be <u>closed for all pupils on Thursday 18th January 2024</u>. School will open as normal on Friday 19th January. Governors and staff are fully aware that this causes disruption to families but parents should be aware that the decision

to strike is not taken lightly by any member of staff. Unions and employers continue to meet but the absence of a Stormont Executive hinders these negotiations and Creates a vacuum.
