In addition to our Integration Breakfast on 15<sup>th</sup> March, this grant also allows us to offer Breakfast Club for free during Integration Month. So, whether you are a regular attender at our Breakfast Club or have never been before, you are welcome to attend this during the month of March for free.

### Free Pizza Fridays

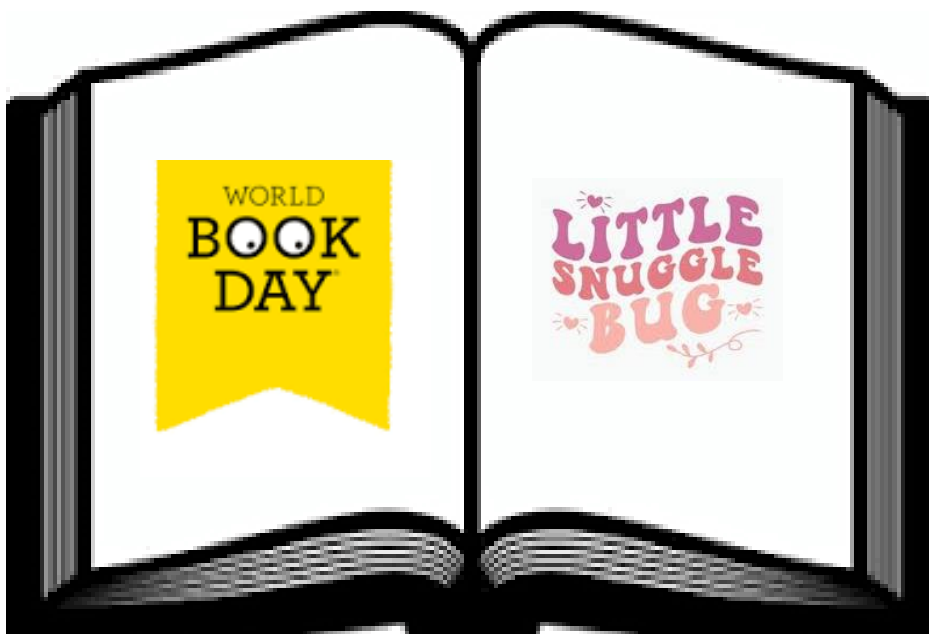
